Montana Plane Crash The Rest of the Story

Family of Irving 'Bud' Feldkamp, owner of the nation's largest privately owned abortion chain, dies in Montana plane crash

Some of you may have seen the major news story of the private plane that crashed into a Montana cemetery, killing 7 children and 7 adults.

But what the news sources fail to mention is that the Catholic Holy Cross Cemetery owned by Resurrection Cemetery Association in Butte - contains a memorial for local residents to pray the rosary, at the 'Tomb of the Unborn'. This memorial,

located a short distance west of the church, was erected as a dedication to all babies who have died because of abortion.

What else is the mainstream news not telling you? The family who died in the crash near the location of the abortion victim's memorial, is the family of Irving 'Bud' Feldkamp, owner of the largest for-profit abortion chain in the nation.

Family Planning Associates was purchased four years ago by Irving Moore "Bud" Feldkamp III, owner of Allcare and Hospitality Dental Associates and CEO of Glen Helen Raceway Park in San Bernardino . The 17 California Family Planning clinics perform more abortions in the state than any other abortion provider - Planned Parenthood included - and they perform abortions through the first five months of pregnancy.

Although Feldkamp is not an abortionist, he reaps profits of blood money from the tens of thousands of babies that are killed through abortions performed every year at the clinics he owns. His business in the abortion industry was what enabled him to afford the private plane that was carrying his family to their week- long vacation at The Yellowstone Club, a millionaires- only ski resort.

The plane went down on Sunday, killing two of Feldkamp's daughters, two sons-in-law and five grandchildren along with the pilot and four family friends. The plane, a single-engine turboprop flown by Bud Summerfield of Highland, crashed into the Catholic cemetery and burst into flames, only 500 ft. from its landing destination. All aboard were killed.

The cause of the crash is a mystery. The pilot, who was a former military flier who logged over 2,000 miles [hours?], gave no indication to air traffic controllers that the aircraft was experiencing difficulty when he asked to divert to an airport in Butte. Witnesses report that the plane suddenly nosedived toward the ground with no apparent signs of a struggle. There was neither a cockpit voice recorder nor a flight data recorder onboard, and no radar clues into the planes final moments because the Butte airport is not equipped with a radar facility. Some speculate that the crash was due to ice on the wings, but this particular plane model has been tested for icy weather and experts have stated that ice being the cause is unlikely.

In my time working for Survivors of the Abortion Holocaust, I helped organize and conduct a weekly campaign where youth activists stood outside of Feldkamp's mini-mansion in Redlands holding fetal development signs and raising community awareness regarding Feldkamp's dealings in child murder for profit. Every Thursday afternoon we called upon Bud and his wife Pam to repent, seek God's blessing and separate themselves from the practice of child killing.

We warned him, for his children's sake, to wash his hands of the innocent blood he assisted in spilling because, as Scripture warns, if "*you did not hate bloodshed, bloodshed will pursue you*". (Ezekiel 35:6).

Note from Pastor Kevin: The full Scripture passage is:

Because you [Mount Seir, another name for the Edomites, who slaughtered the Jews] have had an ancient hatred, and have shed the blood of the children of Israel by the power of the sword at the time of their calamity, when their iniquity came to an end, therefore, as I live," says the LORD GOD, "I will prepare you for blood, and blood shall pursue you; since you have not hated blood, therefore blood shall pursue you. (Ezekiel 35:5-6 NKJV)

A news source states that Bud Feldkamp visited the site of the crash with his wife and their two surviving children on Monday. As they stood near the twisted and charred debris talking with investigators, light snow fell on the tarps that covered the remains of their children.

I don't want to turn this tragic event into some creepy spiritual 'I told you so' moment, but I think of the time spent outside of Feldkamp's. Pam Feldkamp laughing at the fetal development signs, Bud Feldkamp trying not to make eye contact as he got into his car with a small child in tow. And I think of the haunting words, 'Think of your children.' I wonder if those words were haunting Feldkamp as well as he stood in the snow among the remains of loved ones, just feet from the 'Tomb of the Unborn'?

I only hope and pray that in the face of this tragedy, Feldkamp recognizes his need for repentance and reformation. I pray that God will use this unfortunate catastrophe to soften the hearts of Bud and Pam and that they will draw close to the Lord and wash their hands of the blood of thousands of innocent children, each as precious and irreplaceable as their own.

"I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. Choose life, then." (Deuteronomy 30:19)

I agree with Gingi that we have to be careful about turning this tragic event into "some creepy spiritual 'I told you so' moment." But for those who believe there is a God of the Bible who watches over the affairs of man, this very well could be a statement by God that his longsuffering and mercy are not inexhaustible.

An atheist blogger (<u>http://scienceblogs.com/pharyngula/2009/03/a_heartless_faith.php</u>) states that Christians are cruel for hinting this plane crash was a God ordained payback against Mr. Feldkamp for his abortion business. In true atheist form, he totally ignores how *God* feels when he sees Mr. Feldkamp's assassins-for-hire ripping babies out of the wombs of their mothers, nor does he care about the feelings of the large percentage of these women who then suffer for the rest of their lives, regretting the death of their children before they could even hold them in their arms and also how they suffer from the guilt experienced by knowing they were complicit in their baby's death.

The Bible *does* speak to how God must feel about Mr. Feldkamp and his family earning millions of dollars in the business of killing babies, and then using the proceeds to live their millionaire lifestyles: God makes it clear that He forms life in the womb.

For You formed my inward parts; you covered me in my mother's womb. (Psalm 139:13 NKJV)

Thus says **the LORD Who made you and formed you from the womb**, who will help you: "Fear not, O Jacob My servant; and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen." (Isaiah 44:2 NKJV)

Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, and **He who formed you from the womb**: "I am the LORD, who makes all things, who stretches out the heavens all alone, who spreads abroad the earth by Myself." (Isaiah 44:24 NKJV)

And now the LORD says, who formed Me from the womb to be His Servant... (Isaiah 49:5 NKJV)

Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations." (Jeremiah 1:4-6 NKJV)

Therefore, every life at the moment of conception is precious in the sight of God and God has special compassion on children. Jesus rebuked His disciples for trying to keep the children away from Him.

Then they brought young children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. "Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of

God as a little child will by no means enter it." And He took them up in His arms, put His hands on them, and blessed them. (Mark 10:13-16 NKJV)

God is also more merciful than we can comprehend. As Jesus was being tortured and crucified (moments away from experiencing death on our behalf), He cried out from the cross, "*Father forgive them for they know not what they do*" (Luke 23:24 NKJV). I am sure that cry has gone out in heaven millions of times as God the Father looks down and sees baby after baby being tortured and killed in various barbaric ways by abortionists and their profiteers.

I grieve for Mr. Feldkamp and his blindness. He obviously does not know what he is doing. If he understood the true impact of his actions in the sight of the almighty, holy, all-knowing God, he would have fallen to his knees in repentance, begging for God's forgiveness, long ago.

Those who mistake God's mercy for reason to believe He does not exist or does not care should consider that God's mercy is not infinite and will ultimately be replaced by His justice.

The LORD executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed. He made known His ways to Moses, his acts to the children of Israel. The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in mercy. He will not always strive with us, nor will He keep His anger forever. He has not dealt with us according to our sins, nor punished us according to our iniquities. For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great is His mercy toward those who fear Him...As a father pities his children, so the LORD pities those who fear Him. For He knows our frame; he remembers that we are dust. (Psalm 103:6-11,13-14 NKJV)

Imagine if a father of a large family is tied up by a robber who then tortures and murders members of his family, one by one, in front of his eyes. The scene would bring unimaginable horror and tears to the eyes of anyone who has even a grain of compassion in their heart. But those tears would turn to contempt if the father had the ability to free himself and put a stop to the murder of even one more of his precious children, but did not. Indeed, one could rightfully question whether the father actually believed his children *were* precious if he failed to act on their behalf.

God's mercy is continuing for Mr. Feldkamp. He is still alive even though God may have shown him in the deaths of his own loved ones that God is not restrained and is fully capable of putting a stop to the killing of His innocents. It is only His mercy that is delaying His justice and all murderers (of the young, the old, and the in-between) should take pause in what they are doing because justice in God's perfect timing will certainly replace mercy.

It is my prayer that in the midst of Mr. Feldkamp's agony over the loss of his family members, that he will consider what he has done to the children who are precious in God's sight, and repent – call on the name of the Lord for forgiveness of sin by humbling himself before God and begging his forgiveness, which is offered only in the shed blood of Jesus, before it is too late.

If he does not, then God's eternal judgment will fall upon him, and the blood of every baby who was slaughtered in his abortion factories will be on his hands when he stands before Almighty God, the thought of which brings tears to my eyes because of the eternal damnation he will experience because of his blindness.

"Because they have forsaken Me and made this an alien place, because they have burned incense in it to other gods whom neither they, their fathers, nor the kings of Judah have known, and have filled this place with the blood of the innocents "they have also built the high places of Baal, to burn their sons with fire [or chemicals of saline abortion] for burnt offerings to Baal, which I did not command or speak, nor did it come into My mind), "therefore behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "that this place shall no more be called Tophet or the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, but the Valley of Slaughter. (Jeremiah 19:4-6 NKJV)

As a final note, I asked a member of our congregation to make sure this story was accurate before I posted it. The following was her response:

From everything I have found, it appears that Feldkamp, father/grandfather of nine of the victims and owner of the plane, has made millions off of the abortion business and has been the target many pro-life rallies. I was unable to get a photo of the Tomb of the Unborn but a number of Catholic bloggers referred to it, so it must be factual.

The article stated that he was not actually an abortionist and his other businesses (Allcare and Hospitality Dental) offer dental services. However, this Dr. Feldkamp is listed as doing business in Mission Hills at the same address as one of the FPA clinic locations.
